




Tournaments on

International Freestyle Wrestling Tournament



Since 1990 Krasnovarsk has annually staged freestyle wrestling competitions within the framework of International tournament for the prizes of twice Olympic champion, president of the Russian Wrestling Federation, Ivan Sergeevich Yarygin, This sport event attracts the attention of many outstanding sportsmen of the world, who consider it an honor to take part in such prestigious competitions. The wrestlers from all parts of the globe come to the tournament, demonstrating their skills, boldness and strength on the rugs of our splendid palace of sports, Yenisei. Some 200 sportsmen of all weight categories compete for the first place; now we expect over 200 wrestlers from different countries to participate. By December 10, 23 teams from the U.S.A., Germany, China, Japan, Turkey, Iran, Macedonia, Poland, Estonia, Korea, Belarus and Kazakhstan declared their intention to participate. The Krasnoyarsk fans are looking forward to this event, slated for January 26.

always feel glad when our region stages events, related to culture, science and sports. And it's very gratifying that the level of these events is growing from one year to the next. Krasnoyarsk is becoming an international sports center in Siberia. Quite recently we housed the competition between the strongest draught-players of the world - A.Chizhov and A.Balyakin, who competed for the world champion title. And now a new world tournament, the pre-Olympic tournament of the strongest wrestlers of the world.


The sport of the highest achievements, like culture, has a host of peculiarities. Culture and sports do not exist by themselves, but are accompanied by a number of concomitants. For example, the Krasnoyarsk teams and sportsmen, achieving the highest results in prestigious international competitions, not only bring glory and popularity to the Krasnoyarsk region. Foreign firms also display keen interest in the region, making a lot of lucrative proposals. Our prestige, as a business partner,

is growing. It is largely due to sports that a breakthrough to the world market has been made. Businessmen, tourists, stars of sports and culture are coming to us. Sports committees and federations more often suggest to hold large competitions. And this, certainly, adds to the region's prestige. It will not be an exaggeration to say that the international freestyle wrestling tournament for the prizes of the twice Olympic champion I.S. Yarygin is the most popular and prestigious sports competition. All the world follows it closely. Now, on the threshold of the Olympic games, marking their centenary, the tournament and the European freestyle wrestling championship are major knock-out competitions. That's why nearly all the strongest wrestlers of the world stated their readiness to participate. These tournaments always capture the attention of the world public. They have a propagandist effect: following these competitions, young people begin to attend sports clubs and hundredth of people think in earnest of healthy mode of life.

Ivan Yarygin has made an outstanding contribution to the development of sports. His name is known in all continents and we are proud that he is our fellow-countryman. I'd like to point out one detail. More often than not famous sportsmen, upon completing their sports career, simply vanished out of sight. They can hardly find their road outside sport. Now the situation has changed. The chances of these people has largely increased. Ivan Yarygin is a good example of that. He is the president of the Russian Federation of freestyle wrestling, sports organizer of international class. And this is how it should be. Or take, for example, the problems of the region's sports schools. We've managed to preserve most of these schools, but not all of them can successfully tackle their problems. The school of Dmitry Georgievich Mindiashvili, enjoying no particular privilege, stands firmly on its feet and is a true forge of champions in wrestling. Mindiashvili, a former sportsman, found himself as a trainer and organizer and rallied round himself a hardworking collective of like-minded persons. This is a true sports character and that's why Ivan Yarygin remembers him as the best coach and instructor.

We, in Krasnoyarsk, are exponents of the new concept of sports development. Sports propagates a healthy way of life, making use of show-business elements. We are still to learn to organically combine them. One can, of course, train the body in the basement, made into sports clubs in roughand-ready fashion. However, the spiritual development can't proceed in the basement. We must turn sports clubs into Palaces of culture and stadiums. And this is how it will be. The artificial ice which our Swedish colleagues help us develop in Krasnoyarsk, will be free for our children and teenagers. Please, come, train and rest. However, we are against compulsory mass sports. The practice of many years has shown that it does not produce the desired results. And the only result we expect is the following - each of us should grasp the importance of strong health and take care of it independently.

I wish the residents of Krasnoyarsk and the guests of our city to enjoy the tournament for the Ivan Yarygin prize and think of a healthy way of life.

have everything necessary for physical training, as well as for going in for sports. Under the current pressures the country is living through now, we have managed to preserve the personnel, the system of management and coordination of one of the most important area of people's life. Sports and the physical training are an integral part of our life; they have become a necessity.

I'd like to stress that the leaders of the region and the city, local administrations and many enterprises and organizations realize the importance of physical training, actively support it and render all kind of assistance. Late in January, we shall be staging the VII international freestyle wrestling tournament for the Ivan Yarygin prizes. We prepare this sports holiday jointly with all the Krasnoyarsk residents, who want it to be bright and memorable.

The tournament is, in essence, a training session, conducted in the run up to the European championships, Olympic games and, most important - the World championships, slated to be held here, in Krasnoyarsk, in 1997. That why the strongest teams intend to participate - almost all 1995 world champions. So, the competitions in the "Yenisei" Palace of Sports will be rather tough and spectacular. I am sure the fans will enjoy them greatly. Everybody is interested in providing a high level of the tournament - the organizing committee, sports federations, Krasnoyarsk agencies, departments and our sponsors.

Yarygin, born in a small village at the foothills of Sayan Mountains, was "found" by V.I.Charkov, now an honorable coach of the USSR and the Russian Federation, in 1966 in Abakan, where the boy learned driving. Soon Charkov sent him to Krasnoyarsk, where Ivan Yarygin met Dmitry Georgievich Mindiashvili. The latter trained Yarygin from 1968 to 1980.

I. Yarygin has become twice Olympic champion, the world champion, the four-time European champion and the five-time holder of the world's cup. Ivan Yarygin first won the title of Olympic champion in 1972 in Munich. After the victory he would say: "Yes, I have won quite easily, though these quick attacks absorbed everything - pain, sweat and long years of training. I've set up an unofficial record in wrestling: seven close engagements took 12 minutes out of 63 allotted." It's not easy to climb to the Olympic height, but it's still more difficult to confirm the title of the Olympic champion.

To participate in the XXI Olympic games, held in Montreal, the athlete from Krasnoyarsk had to prove to the coaches of the combined team that, despite his shattered prestige, he will not let them down at the decisive moment.

And again our fellow-countryman - the Olympic champion!


"I was engaged in combat and saw myself as if in a mirror. My opponent did not give in, he also attacked, putting on my favorite spurts. The score is 9:13."

In 1980, Ivan Sergeevich was appointed chief coach of the USSR combined freestyle wrestling team. He is an honorable coach of the USSR.

Despite the fact that Ivan Sergeevich has been living and working in Moscow for many years, this tournament is held on the banks of Yenisei, as it was here that he had become a distinguished sportsman and won the title of an honorary citizen of Krasnoyarsk.

In 1992, Ivan Sergeevich was elected president of the Russian Wrestling Federation. He devotes much time and effort to promoting this kind of sport in our difficult time.

The successes, scored by the Russian wrestlers in the international competitions of late, inspire hope that the glorious traditions of freestyle wrestlers will not die.




Siberian Rug

"I keep recalling the recent cup tournament, those hundreds and thousands of Krasnoyarsk city dwellers who turned then into spectators or even fans. The tournament was conceived as the one, linked with the name of Ivan Yarygin - a legendary man in life and sports. He is not only an outstanding sportsman, but a man who, in the difficult years of nascent market relations, proved to be an able sports organizer. When he became president of the Russian Wrestling Federation, the latter's prestige had noticeably increased. I.Yarygin has many worthy qualities. Rafi Martinetti, Vice President of the International Free-Style Wrestling Federation:

- For me, Siberia and Russia are inseparable. At the opening ceremony at the Yenisei Palace of Sports I'd rather felt the Russian heart, the Russian boldness, your national folk lore.

Arsen Fadzaev, chief coach of Russia's combined team:

Nugzar Zhuruli, chief referee of the local tournament:

The level of the preparation for the tournament is up to the world standards. All necessary conditions have been created not only for the competitors and referees, but for the spectators as well. The stron-

gest wrestlers are true to themselves: their attacks are fierce. Each combat - within the limits of the possible. No wonder, since those who lose are out and can't take part in other competitions.

Aleksei Okmoyev, coach (Yakutia):

- I think that the tournament is of the highest class. We specially arrived in Krasnoyarsk to witness the fight of the free-style wrestlers from different countries. There are things to learn. For educational purposes, we are making a videofilm to show it later to our boys. The tournament is very useful to us, sportsmen of Russia's hinterland.

Orudzhiev Vugar, honorable master of sports (Vladikavkaz):

- Everything is all right, the competitors are strong, the selection is tough, the referees are skilled, though there were some mistakes. I am glad that eight North Ossetian wrestlers won 3-4 and 1-2 places on the second day of the finals. Our president sent a telegram of congratulation. This testifies to the attention our republic pays to the development of sports. When I was leaving Yevlakh, a small locality, not far from Nagorny Karabakh, my parents and relatives wished me success. And I did achieve it, winning the first place in my weight category.

Lidia Soboleva, deputy chief physician of the Krasnoyarsk sanitary and epidemiological inspection center:

- I have been closely following wrestling since 1973. I attended practically all major competitions in Krasnoyarsk. I am glad to see the famed sportsman, Sergei Beloglazov, as well as Yuri Shakhmuradov, the coach of Japan's combined team.

The tournament is a spectacular sight, both in form and content. This holiday makes my heart smile.

Sergei Kashnikov, master of sports, international class, twice European champion (wrestling):

- The tournament is distinguished by the warmth of reception and good organization. Almost no blunders.

As to the wrestling itself, I think it lacks technique. Attacks are rare. But this is my opinion of preliminary competitions. The first finals proved more aggressive and, consequently, spectacular.



van Yarygin, Viktor Alexeev, Vitaly Tokchinakov, Vladimir Botnya, Akhmed Atavov, Vladimir Modosyan, Abdullah Magomedov - they all have graduated from the Krasnoyarsk school of wrestling. The school is well-known for its topclass master graduates. It is led by Dmitry G. Mindiashvili, merited coach of the USSR and the Russian Federation. Some of the wrestlers have become coaches themselves, new athletes have appeared. Buvaisar Saitiyev, 20, who lives in Krasnoyarsk is one of them. In the 1995 season he won at every possible competition, including the Ivan Yarygin competitions, at the youth competition, and later at the world championships. It is not accidental that the winner is on the list of "Russia's three Olympic hopefuls" by the results of the 1995 pre-Olympic year.

Virtually, Saitiyev is not a Siberian. Three-odd years ago he and his best friend Islam Matiyev who is also a smart freestyle wrestler arrived in Krasnoyarsk from Khasavyurt, a town in Daghestan (the Russian Federation's constituent republic). They had learned about the city's school of wrestling and moved to live and train there. Buvaisar sees himself as a real Siberian now, he maintains the school is very good and training there is difficult but effective. He and his friend are missing their native land, but do not believe they can do without Krasnoyarsk, its mat, the school and their new friends. Saitiyev's elder brother, Abdullah who is also a wrestler, was the first to come to live in Krasnoyarsk. Abdullah practiced for a year, became a master of sport, then was called up for military service and served in the Kemerovo region.

Virtuoso on the Rug

Upon returning home, Abdullah told Buvaisar and Islam a lot about training on the Krasnoyarsk mat. Later all-round world champion Akhmed Atavov and European champion Abdullah Magomedov came for a visit to their native Khasavyurt, they were idolized by local children. The champions advised the two friends to go to Krasnoyarsk. After the first twelve months of training in the school Saitiyev and Matiyev won at a European youth competitions.

Buvaisar was lucky that major international wrestling competitions that award prizes named after two times Olympic champion Ivan Yarygin are held annually in Krasnoyarsk. Buvaisar was taken notice of two years ago at the competitions when he won in the weight category under 68 kg.

The Russian national team's chief coacher Arsen Fadzaev said at the time that Buvaisar was a good boy, but not quite fit physically, not yet formed as a man, not quite ready. But Ivan Yarygin himself was of high opinion of the guy.

In January 1994 Buvaisar was really smart, after his victory over Valery Gulchiyev he encountered Sounders Tousend. However, the situation was developing not in his favor. The referees "played into the hands" of the guest from oversees. They did not take into consideration a throw of Buvaisar, but his competitor got three points and was in the lead with a score 3:1. Then Tousend twice applied a hold and got another four points, while Saitiyev - only two. And at the moment when the situation was seemingly desperate and the score was 3:7, Buvaisar executed a brilliant throw and got four points thus equalling the score.

After that, Saitiyev quickly reached victory and made short word of European champion "iron" Boris Budayev from Buryatia with a score 7:1.

Early in 1995 Buvaisar began to appear in a heavier category, under 74 kg, in which well-known wrestlers perform. At the competitions named after Ivan Yarygin he again made his fans watch his performance with bated breath. In his bout with an experienced wrestler, Saigid Katinovasov from Makhachkala, Buvaisar seemed to be losing with a score 1:6. But he again like a year ago managed to pull himself together and won. He also gained victory visually without any effort over his other competitors and in the final bout with American Pete Smith he was also the winner. Buvaisar executed two excellent throws and then applied a head under arm and crotch lift and

after applying an effective shoulder throw he got five points and deafening applause.

At present Russia's team's coach Arsen Fadzaev believes that Saitiyev has matured and performs smartly with great exactness in his movements. He is a real candidate to become a member of Russia's Olympic national team. Buvaisar has justified hopes. Last year his ascent of podiums began. At the championship Fadzaev included him into the national team to take part in the Atlanta world championship. This year's Olympic games will be held there. Buvaisar was a success. He gained victory over a very self-confident Alexander Lipold from Germany.

No one realized that Saitiyev won with only one "working" leg. Late in 1994 at a training before the Yarygin competitions he injured his knee, it ached and before bouts doctors had to anaesthetize it. Now the wrestler has undergone an operation, plaster has been removed and Buvaisar Saitiyev started training again. This season is special because of the Olympic games. Islam Matiyev is also ready to take part in regular Yarygin competitions after winning at the Kazakhstan international championships.

Well, good luck to the friends on the Krasnoyarsk mat.

■ CHAMPION'S BOOK

GAMES FOR REAL MEN

n November 1995 the Krasnoyarsk book publishers brought out a second revised edition of Games for Real Men by I.S. Yarygin, a twotime Olympic champion in freestyle wrestling and president of the Russian Freestyle Wrestling Federation. In it, the outstanding athlete tells a story of his life, recalling how a simple country boy made a brilliant career in sports. Yarygin tells of past and present champions and of his hard yet rewarding work as the chief coach of the national freestyle wrestling team.

"I first hit upon an idea to write a book at the 1982 world championship in Canada," says Yarygin. "We had tremendous success there, all our wrestlers having won prizes... As a rule, the sports press does not have much interest in wrestling, which is surprising indeed. Nowadays freestyle wrestling is getting more and more popular, Russian athletes score ever new victories, and yet most of sports journalists do not pay any particular attention to wrestlers. There are very few articles or books devoted to my sport, and that is really unfair.

In talking of myself I hope to be able to show the democratic spirit of men's contest, the beauty of it."

The author recalls his first steps in sport; he describes dozens of wonderful people who happened to be near him, helping him and bolstering his belief in himself, who shared his joys and sorrows on the thorny path of athlete.

As the reader will undoubtedly notice, Yarygin does not present himself as a kind of superman, but focuses his attention on those who surrounded him, whom he met and worked with. The book is virtually crammed with known personalities and men in the street, legendary wrestlers and ordinary sports fans.

The author is convincing in every particular detail when he describes the hard toil of an athlete. Each success is bought at the price of great risks, moral suffering and self-sacrifice.

The last pages of the book deal with the VII International Freestyle Wrestling Tournament to be held this year. Both athletes and fans look forward to this fascinating sports event.

"What a wonderful city my Krasnoyarsk is," says Yarygin of his home town on the Yenisei River. "Life is hard for people here. There are a lot of things they cannot afford. And still the city manages to award its winners with valuable prizes.

Organization of an international tournament today requires a lot of effort to be put in by various bodies and individuals. Sometimes I am really amazed at the willingness and enthusiasm the sports community of the region display in overcoming numerous difficulties. This refers above all to the regional Physical Training and Sports Committee headed by its chairman Vladimir Chernykh."

Games for Real Men is an excellent present made by I.S. Yarygin and the publishing house for guests and participants of the VII International Freestyle Wrestling Tournament. It is a clever, captivating and sincere book. As a matter of fact, it is another contribution of the outstanding athlete to the development of such a marvellous sport as freestyle wrestling.

nternational freestyle wrestling tournaments have invariably aroused great interest on the part of the press. Journalists usually attend every single event of the tournament, meeting both wrestlers and their coaches and referees, event organizers and fans.

Sixty-eight mass media people were accredited at the VI International Freestyle Wrestling Tournament. They represented about 20 newspapers, TV companies and information agencies.

The clubs unite true enthusiasts of freesty wrestling and help youngsters to master the tricks of the trade.

Under the Leadership of an Olympic Champion

year ago Alexei Shumakov, Olympic champion in Graeco-Roman wrestling, became head of the Krasnoyarsk branch of the Air Force Central Sports Club. His name attract ed to the club a lot of Krasnoyarsk athletes, who have scored quite a few victories since. The club athletes took part in the first World Military Games in Rome. Their results are quite impressive: Oleg Nemchenko, master of sports, international class, won the gold medal in Graeco-Roman wrestling; Sergei Kosmynin, honored master of sports, won the silver medal in judo; and Alexei Ogorodnikov, Alexei Lykov and Marina Kovrigina, masters of sports, international class, were ranked among the top five of the world.

"Athletes of our Russian army," says Alexei Shumakov, "won 42 gold medals, that is 20 medals more than the Italians, who came second in the team events after the Russians. No one has expected such a stunning victory from us. I was literally overjoyed, watching Russian athletes."

The Krasnoyarsk School of Champions

he school of the highest sports achievements in wrestling was opened in 1973. Now it is known to all sportsmen of the world.

Hundreds of sportsmen, distinguished masters of international class and those, who are just entering on their sports career, know this building on Markovsky street, downtown Krasnoyarsk. For them, it is the house of wrestling, the school of Dmitry Mindiashvili - an able coach, organizer, instructor and now Vice President of the Russian Wrestling Federation. D.Mindiashvili is a candidate of pedagogical sciences and gets ready to defend doctor's degree on the theme, quite dear to him: "Managing the process of mastering sports skills of trained wrestlers.'

Two years ago D.Mindiashvili published his book of reminiscences "On the Carpet of Life," devoting many pages to the idea of establishing a wrestlers' school and an uphill task to realize the main thing of his life.

Rafi Martinotti, Vice President of the International Wrestling Federation, having familiarized himself with the school, its traditions, methods and Mindiashvili's style of work, said: "Most of all, I admire his immense talent of educator and instructor. If there are great sportsmen, there ought to be great coaches. And if it is so, then Dmitry Mindiashvili is one of them." The school lives a turbulent, interesting life, it turns out wonderful sportsmen, who achieve outstanding results at the competitions of the high-

est class. Over 5,000 people go in for free-style wrestling in the region: in Krasnoyarsk, Divnogorsk, Kansk, Achinsk, Talnakh, Yeniseisk, Lesosibirsk, Uzhur, Uyar, Nazarovo, Sharypovo; as well as in the districts - the Mansk, Partizansky, Uzhursky, Novoselovsky, Balakhtinsky, Sayansky, Ilansky, Abansky, Shushensky and Evenkisky Autonomous district.

To prepare specialists, the Krasnoyarsk technical secondary school of physical training opened a freestyle wrestling department in 1973, while the Krasnoyarsk State Pedagogical University, on the initiative of D.Mindiashvili, opened a wrestling chair in 1995.

Specialized schools of Olympic reserves, functioning in Krasnoyarsk,

Divnogorsk and Minusinsk, also turn out wrestling coaches.

Krasnoyarsk has become a center of International and all-Russia wrestling competitions. In 1995, it held the sixth international freestyle tournament, group A, for the prizes of twice Olympic champion Ivan Yarygin. The tournament involved over 250 wrestlers from Russia and abroad.

The annual international freestyle wrestling junior tournaments for the prizes of twice world champion Viktor Alekseev win the highest appraisal, as well as the Graeco-Roman wrestling tournaments for the prizes of Olympic champion Aleksei Shumakov, all-Russia tournaments, devoted to the memory of V.I.Kotelnikov (freestyle wrestling), tournaments for the prizes of the first Krasnoyarsk champion Anatoly Solopov (Graeco-Roman wrestling). Initially it was established as a freestyle wrestling school; later it became a school for summer sports (freestyle wrestling, Graeco-Roman wrestling and judo) and then transformed into a wrestling school (freestyle wrestling, Graeco-Roman wrestling and unarmed self-defense). Despite all this change the school has always trained first-rate athletes who have scored numerous victories in domestic and international competitions.








Sports Kaleidoscope
